 - Brethren who do not reserve a seat for dinner are requested to arrive at Lodge no earlier than 7:15 p.m. on the 19th as there will be limited space for you until the Lodge room has been reconfigured for business.
 - Brethren who are not attending dinner and arrive earlier than 7:15 p.m. will be asked to wait either outside the Lodge building or in the first floor hall or library until 7:15 p.m.
